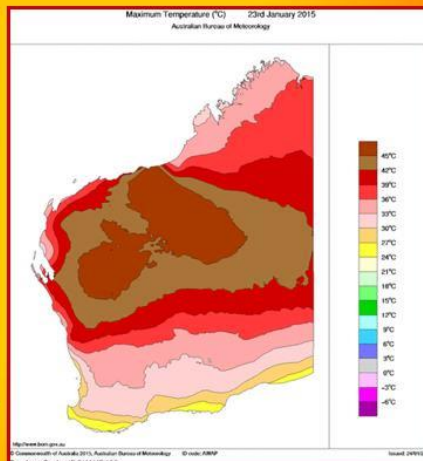


# Marble Bar Still Australia's Hottest Town

Television and print media converged on Marble Bar for a Bureau of Meteorology forecast of 44 degrees on 23 January. The forecast maximum was reached at 3:15pm. It was only .2 of one degree less than the record of 49.2 degrees set on 03 January 1922. Townspeople and visitors were interviewed to gauge the people's reactions to the heat. Apart from the visitors, the locals gave the usual laconic responses like 'Oh, is it hot today?' or 'I thought it felt a little warmer than usual.', much to the media's dismay as we were supposed to be just about dying.
